1. What information about the users do we collect?

- a) Personal Information: We collect the following personal information when you provide it while filling out'Contact Us' form on the website:
 - Name
 - Email
 - Message
- b) Information that we collect when you use the website: We also collect information while you access, browse, or view the website. In other words, when you access the website, we are aware of your usage of the website, and gather, collect, and record the information relating to such usage, including device and connection information, browser information and web-log information. 2. What is the lawful basis for which we use your personal information?

Star Games recognizes the importance of using your personal information in a lawful and transparent manner. To ensure that your data is handled appropriately, we rely on the following lawful bases for processing your personal information:

- i. Legitimate Interests: We collect and use your personal information, including your name, email, and messages, to respond to your inquiries and provide support. This processing is necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by Star Games in providing quality customer service and maintaining effective communication.
- **ii. Consent:** When you voluntarily provide your name, email, and messages through our "Contact Us" form, you consent to the processing of this information for the purpose of communication and support.

We want you to have confidence in how we handle your personal information. 3. How do we use this information?

At Star Games, we use the information collected, including your name, email, and messages, for the following purposes:

5. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Cookies are bits of electronic information that a website may transfer to a visitor's computer to identify specific information about the visitor's visits to another website. The website uses a browser feature known as a cookie, which assigns a unique identification to your computer. 6. Sharing of Information

7. Storage and Security of Information

The Company takes rigorous measures to ensure the storage and security of your information:

- a) Data Storage: Your data is stored through our hosting service provider's data storage, databases, and servers. We also store some of the information collected by us on our computers and do not share it with any third party, except for the limited purposes as mentioned in the Section 6. The servers and databases in which information may be stored may be located outside the State/country from which you accessed this Site, and in a country where the data protection and other laws may differ (and be less stringent) from your country of residence. You hereby consent to any such cross-border transfer of your personal information.
- Access Controls: Access to your data is restricted to authorized personnel with a legitimate need to access

Personal information that is no longer required to fulfil the identified purposes will be destroyed, erased or made de-identified or anonymous.

8. Links to other Sites

We have no control over, and assume no responsibility for such websites and online services. 9. Your Rights under GDPR

This section of the Policy supplements the other provisions of this Privacy Policy, and applies to you if you are in the EU, the European Economic Area (EEA) or UK. For the purposes of GDPR, your DATA CONTROLLER for the

10. California Resident Rights

This section of the Policy applies to you, if you are a California resident, as per California Privacy Rights Act, 2020 (simply called "CPRA"), California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), California Consumer Policy Act, 2018 (simply called "CCPA") and California Online Privacy Protection Act (simply called "COPPA"). This privacy notice section for California residents supplements the information contained in our Privacy Policy and it applies solely to all visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California.

Categories of Personal Information Collected

We collect information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or device. Category I: Professional or employment-related information.

Examples: Current or past job history or performance evaluations.

Category J: Non-public education information (per the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

(20 U.S.C. Section 1232g, 34 C.F.R. Part 99)).

Examples: Education records directly related to a student maintained by an educational institution or party

acting on its behalf, such as grades, transcripts, class lists, student schedules, student identification codes,

student financial information, or student disciplinary records.

Collected: No.

Category K: Inferences drawn from other personal information.

Examples: Profile reflecting a person's preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions,

We use the personal information that we collect or receive for the business purposes as described above. We may

disclose the above listed categories of personal information to third parties for business purposes as described above.

As previously mentioned in this Policy, we do not "sell" (as such term is defined in the CCPA) personal

information.

You are entitled to the following specific rights under the CCPA and CPRA in relation to personal

information related to you:

• You have a right to request that we will disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of

personal information related to you over the past 12 months, including: (i) The categories of personal

information that we collect about you; (ii) The categories of sources from which the personal information is

collected; (iii) The purposes for collecting, using, or selling that personal information. (iv) The categories

of personal information that we disclosed for a business purpose or sold, and the categories of third parties to whom we disclosed or sold that particular category of personal information. (v) The specific pieces of personal information that we have collected about you.

- You have a right to request that we delete personal information related to you that we collected from you
 under certain circumstances and exceptions.
- You also have a right not to be discriminated against for exercising your rights under the CCPA.
- You also have a right to submit your request via an authorized agent. If you use an authorized agent to submit a request to access or delete your personal information on your behalf, the authorized agent must:

 (1) be a person or business entity registered with the California Secretary of State to conduct business in California; (2) provide proof of such registration; and (3) provide documentation or other proof indicating that they are authorized to act on your behalf. We may also require you to verify your identity directly with us, and directly confirm with us that you provided the authorized agent permission to submit the request.

The above rights will only become exercisable by California residents if Auto One falls within the scope of CCPA and/or CRPA. Further, we will verify your request using the information associated with your account, including email address. Government identification may also be required.

A request for access can be made by you only twice within a 12-months period. Any disclosures that we provide will only cover the 12-months period preceding receipt of your request. We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable User request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will inform you of the reasons for such a decision and provide you with a cost estimate before processing further your request.

11. Notice for Nevada Residents

Under Nevada law, certain Nevada residents may opt out of the sale of "personally identifiable information" for monetary consideration to a person for that person to license or sell such information to additional persons.

12. Rights of users from Illinois

laws of the Kingdom of Spain shall be applicable, without regards to its conflict of law provisions, and the disputes

shall be subject to the appropriate courts located in Roses, Spain.
